ABOUT US

The Eden Athletic Club was formally established in 1972, however, Eden basketball has been in the East Bay for over 80 years, when Ashland Gakuen, the precursor to the Eden Japanese Community Center, brought youth basketball to the local JA community.

The need for a sport such as basketball, that stresses physical fitness and recreation in a friendly environment, was evident from the start. Linking those goals with the Eden Japanese American community made it much more than just playing basketball.

This year, the Eden program has over 100 players participating on 11 teams comprised of players from grades K-12 who participate in C, D & E teams in the EBYAL (boys' league) and EBGAL (girls' league).

Our season begins with practice in September, and wraps up after the April tournaments.

In December, EAC parents and players get together for our annual Mochitsuki. The mochi is packaged and delivered locally, and to seniors at the Eden Issei Terrace, just in time for New Year celebrations.

Every June, the Eden Township Bazaar, hosted by Eden JAACL at the Eden Japanese Community Center, is held. Games for children and B-I-N-G-O for adults are supplemented with a generous selection of homemade foods.

Being an Eden parent can require more time and energy than other sport organizations, but it is evident our families benefit from a richer experience — they are part of a community!

Jamboree Rules



Player Eligibility:

- 1) "D" & "E" teams must be roster teams only. The roster shall include only those players who have participated on the team during the regular season in league play. The Jamboree committee must approve players not on the league roster.
- 2) Adding players just before the game will NOT be allowed.
- 3) A liability waiver form must be signed by the parent or legal guardian of each player and be submitted by the team before the player will be allowed to participate. Each team is responsible for its own insurance coverage.
- 4) The Eden Athletic Club, the town of Walnut Creek shall not be held responsible for any injuries to players and/or spectators, or for the loss of players' and/or spectators' personal belongings.

Game Rules:

- 1) All games will be played under the current Official High School Basketball Rules.
- 2) Women's (28.5) collegiate-sized ball will be used for Girls and E divisions. Regulation-sized ball will be used for the D Boys division. Game ball will be offered by the "home" team.
- 3) Game time will be 8-minute quarters, running time. There will be one minute between quarters, and 4 minutes between halves. The clock will be stopped for time outs, free throws, and at the referee's discretion. Stop time will be in effect for the last 2 minutes of the second and fourth quarters.
- 4) All Play Rule: All players in uniform must play at least one quarter (8 minutes) per game (barring injury or disqualification). The first and third quarters will be stopped at four minutes to allow for substitution. All players on the bench must enter at this time. THIS IS NOT A TIME OUT! PLAY IS STOPPED FOR SUBSTITUTION ONLY. If a team has more than 10 players, the additional players must get their playing time in the second and fourth quarters.
- 5) **Time Outs:** There will be 4 time outs per game. One additional time out for each overtime period.

Jamboree Rules (continued)

- 6) **Overtime:** In the event of a tie, there will be one 2-minute (stop time) overtime period. One extra time out will be granted. If the score remains in a tie at the end of overtime, the game shall be decided in a sudden death format: Jump ball from the Center court, with the first team that scores, wins the game. A bonus free throw (“one and one”) will be awarded on the 7th team foul of each half. On the 10th team foul, two free throws will be awarded (Double Bonus).
- 7) A Bonus free throw (One and One) will be awarded on the 7th team foul of each half. On the 10th team foul, **two** free throws will be awarded (Double Bonus).
- 8) “E” divisions will shoot free throws 10 feet from the basket or from the bottom of the free throw circle.
- 9) Backcourt pressure will not be allowed. However, “D” division gold boys will be allowed full court press.
- 10) The alternate possession rule will be in effect for all divisions.
- 11) Three points will be awarded for goals scored beyond the 3-point line (when line is present).
- 12) 3-second rule in the key will be in effect for “D” division. 5 seconds will be allowed for “E” division.
- 13) Any team not ready to play within 10 minutes of the scheduled start time will forfeit that game. The game may be played, but the game time may be amended at the discretion of the Gym Coordinator.
- 14) An automatic 2 point penalty and loss of possession will be imposed for each technical foul.
- 15) In an effort to provide a competitive game between teams the “Mercy Rule” shall be in effect whenever the point spread between teams becomes greater than 20 points.

The leading team will have the following rules of restricted play imposed on them until the point spread is reduced to below the 20 point level.

No defense beyond the 3-point line when line is present. If there is no 3-point line, then the defense will need to stay behind the top of the free throw line circle and approximately where the 3-point line would be on the sides.

Jamboree Rules (continued)

The scorer’s table has the responsibility to notify both the coaches and referees when the 20 point differential is close, and/or when it has been exceeded at which time the score board will be turned off for E division games. The restrictions on play shall be enforced by the referees and shall be applied by the leading team’s coach. If the coach is not actively attempting to encourage his team to enlist the above listed play restrictions, the referee(s) shall assess the following:

1st violation is a warning by the referee

2nd violation is a 1 shot Technical foul invoked on the coach

3rd violation is a 2 shot Technical foul invoked on the coach, with automatic ejection from the contest.

4th violation is an immediate forfeiture of the game by the leading team.

Protests:

Any protests regarding ineligible players must be made before the start of the game. A forfeit will result if the violating team wins and the player in question plays.

Any forfeit regarding the game must be made within ten minutes of the game’s completion to the Jamboree gym supervisor, or manager.

General:

Players may not wear jewelry or metal hair clips of any kind.

Numbers on uniforms should correspond to the submitted roster.

Only players, coaches, and assistant coaches are allowed to sit on the team bench.

Only the head coach may stand up while on the sideline, and call timeouts from the sideline.

This is not tournament play, where the emphasis is historically on winning. This event is offered to promote sportsmanship and extend friendship to the participants. Above all, have a good time and enjoy the games!

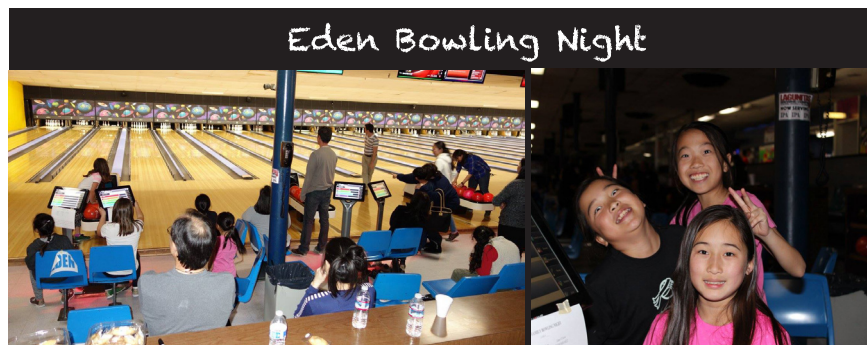

The Eden Japanese Community Center has served as a hub of Japanese American culture for over 80 years, and we in the Eden Athletic Club are very grateful for all the collective efforts of the people who helped to establish the center.

The center got its start in 1931, when Minoru and Masa Okada donated farmland for construction of the Ashland Gakuen, the Eden center's precursor. Japanese American children from the East Bay commuted here for after-school Japanese language instruction, and the gakuen served as a social gathering place as well. The gakuen thrived for over 10 years until JA Internment in 1942. The school hall functioned

as a hostel for returning and relocating Japanese Americans for the few years following 1946.

In 1960, the Eden Township Chapter of the Japanese American Citizens League organized an effort to rebuild a community center at the site. Original construction was completed in 1962.

Today, the center is busy nearly every night of the year. Aside from providing a home for the EAC, the center serves as home of the Eden Chapter JACL, the Eden Youth Group, and the Eden Senior Center. Arts schools that meet and practice here include the Eden Aoba Taiko, Hashimoto Karate Dojo, Ohtori Kinsen Kai Okinawan theatrical dance dojo, and an ikebana club.
